The pepperoni fundraiser will begin October 2nd and run until October 16th. Please note we are on a tight schedule and will not be able to accept orders that are not in the Pepperoni drawer **located in the band room** by 2:00 pm on October 16th.

Attached you will find the **That's a Wrap Café order sheet** and **Order Tally Sheet** for you to use to provide a tally of your orders. Please note that each roll costs \$2.00 and the band member will earn \$1.00 per pepperoni roll sold for their fundraising account. **We now have four varieties to choose from – they all earn the same amount for the kids.**

Please return the completed **Order Tally Sheet** (keep the Order Form for your records) along with **ONE CHECK** made payable to TJ Band Patrons Inc. and place both items in the Pepperoni Order Form drawer in the band room **no later than 2 PM on October 16, 2018**. No orders can be accepted after this time and **no cash** will be accepted.

All rolls will be available for pick up on Tuesday, October 30th in the High School Cafeteria from 4:30 pm till 6:00 pm. If you are unable to pick up your order, please make arrangements for someone to pick it up for you. We do not have storage options for the pepperoni rolls.

Below you will find some FAQ's

Can the pepperoni rolls be frozen?

The pepperoni rolls can be frozen because they are made fresh and never frozen. It is suggested that you place them in freezer safe bags to ensure proper freshness.

Is there peanut oil in the pepperoni rolls?

Peanut oil products are not used in the preparation of the pepperoni rolls.

How big are the pepperoni rolls?

They are 7 inches long and are individual wrapped. **They are packaged 13 to a box.**

These rolls make a great appetizer or after school snack.
